Whose sin is covered.

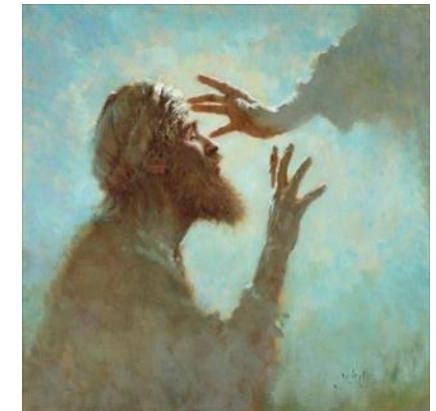
Blessed is the one to whom
