ADORATION on Holy Thursday - We ask that people who will be staying for the adoration bring a cushion (to kneel on) and a small blanket as it may be a little cooler in the hall. The floor will be covered with mats with chairs available for those who are not able to sit or kneel on the mats. (Please bring a gift of non-perishable food for the poor for the offertory on Holy Thursday)

To our Indian community, we have allocated a time slot for you on Holy Thursday for adoration, so we encourage you all to join and participate.

There will be a collection on Good Friday for the Holy Land. This will take place when you go up to kiss the cross. Baskets will be placed next to the cross for your offering.

The Holy Father's **Good Friday Collection** is a small gesture of solidarity for the Christian communities that still walk in the footsteps of Jesus. Our New Zealand Collection is given for the upkeep of the Shrine Church in Cana, Galilee, and 20 university scholarships to Bethlehem University. In 1342 the Franciscans were confirmed as the legitimate guardians of the Holy Land. Funds donated in NZ are forwarded to the Franciscan Commissary of the Holy Land and then sent to Rome, to be distributed to the Holy Land. Please give generously to this collection in support of our brothers and sisters living in the Holy Land.

There will be a **rehearsal for all those who will take part in the Easter Vigil on Saturday 3 April at 10.00 am.** All those who would like to be altar servers to please put their names down on the registration form in the foyer.
