► **VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THOSE WHO WORK IN THE PARISH WITH CHILDREN AND VULNERABLE ADULTS.**

Pope Francis has made it very clear that the church at every level must implement processes and policies to protect minors and vulnerable persons. For the past 2 years, under the guidance of the Diocese of Auckland, parishes have been working towards becoming compliant as Safe Workplaces. A number of you have completed training and police vetting documentation. (Some who have been asked have not quite got around to it!). **From 30 September 2021, anyone who has not completed the training and police vetting requirements will be unable to continue their ministry within the parish. This includes all those who work with children and young adults – Sunday School Teachers & Leaders, Leaders of Children’s Liturgy, Altar Servers Co-ordinators, Youth Group Leaders and all those who visit the elderly at home.** Our priests and the teachers in the school have completed the process as have many of those who take Holy Communion to the Sick. It is not difficult to become accredited – fill in the vetting form, produce photographic ID and attend a short workshop which we are planning to have in the Parish on September 26 after 10am Mass. Pat in the Office can provide the forms and certify your ID. Any questions can be raised with Father Mathew.
