Deal bountifully with your servant, so that I may live and observe your word.

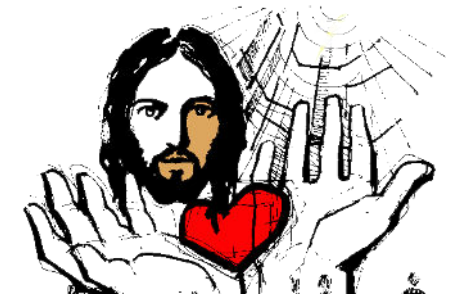
Open my eyes, so that I may behold wondrous things out of your law.
