Dear Parishioners

In the second reading this Sunday, Saint Paul in his letter to the Corinthians humbly acknowledges his weaknesses. We should also have the humility, as had Paul, to recognise and accept our weaknesses. Humility keeps us honest, makes us wise, and gives us gratitude for what we have received. Pride and envy are the enemy of humility; they blind us to the real good in a neighbour. These vices blinded the Pharisees when they refused to see any good in Jesus himself. They refused to see anything but a carpenter of Nazareth. We, too, if we care to admit it, can be so blind with regard to our neighbour.

God's desire for the Church is that it be an harmonious whole, and only when we can truly appreciate the good in a neighbour can we hope to work in harmony. God made us social beings.
